The Field Research on early childhood care and education in Jordan

This is a report of the visits to five kindergarten sites and two homes in Anman and Madaba in Jordan from the 17th to the 26th of September in 2012.

Three of the kindergarten sites are public ones, one is private and the other is run by UNRWA. Their common purpose is to teach Arabic letters and the numbers. There are some differences in the supply of teaching materials and playing toys among the kindergarten sites. However, all the kindergarten sites have enough teaching supplies and materials which are provided by the support of US AID. Collecting objective data in Jordan is my greatest challenge.
