

Job Opening for Nine Assistant Professors in Pioneering Interdisciplinary Sciences Ochanomizu University

How to Apply

1. Title and Status:

<u>Program-Specific Assistant Professor</u> of Ochanomizu University with a fixed term of employment

2. Term of Employment and Promotion:

The first term is <u>from the appointment day (early December, 2007, at the earliest) to March 31, 2009.</u> The term will be extended to March 31, 2012, based on the interim assessment of the research record. Based on the final assessment by the Selection & Evaluation Committee of Ochanomizu University, the employed assistant professors will obtain tenure and be promoted to associate professor if their research achievements are regarded as excellent.

3. Objectives and job description:

For 3-5 years, each employed assistant professor is expected <u>to lead and manage</u> <u>a research project</u> as PI (Principal Investigator), and <u>to enhance frontier</u> <u>scientific activities and education</u> with outstanding faculty members in the Division of Advanced Interdisciplinary Sciences, which was newly established in the Graduate School of Humanities and Sciences in April, 2007, in order to prioritize creative and innovative research and entrepreneurship.

<u>An interim assessment</u> will be made based on excellence in research results to judge the continuation of the job contract. <u>A final assessment</u> will also be made within the 5^{th} year.

- **5.** Salary: The salary after social insurance contribution, tax and benefits is about \$6,200,000 per year.
- 6. **Research funds:** Between ¥1,000,000 and ¥10,000,000 per year including equipment. The program-specific assistant professor can apply for competitive research funds in Japan. For research assistance, one post-doctoral level program-specific research fellow is employed, if necessary.

8. Application and selection

(1) Qualifications:

Candidates should hold <u>Ph.D. degrees</u> granted within the past 10 years (as of August 1, 2007), and have <u>outstanding research experience</u> and <u>excellent</u> <u>ability to perform creative and independent research</u>.

(2) Submission of application documents:

- **a.** Application form (*Please use the Application Form on page 4 of this manual of "How to Apply".)
- **b.** Curriculum vitae (including education record from university and employment/research record with month/year, and full-face photo)
- **c.** Recommendation letters (2 or more. Please indicate the contact e-mail addresses and affiliations of the recommenders who we can contact as occasion arises.)
- **d.** General outline of previous research achievements (up to 5 pages including key words)
- e. List of achievements (publications, invited talks, awards)
- f. Description of research plan for the program (about 2 pages)
- g. List of facilities and equipment necessary for the research
- **h.** List of grants previously acquired and currently applied
- i. Offprints or photocopies of major papers (up to 5 papers)
- j. Other references (patents, etc.)

(3) Submission deadline and selection schedule

- a. Submission deadline of application documents: October 1, 2007
- b. Selection schedule:

1st review: in October, 2007

2nd review: from the end of October to the end of November, 2007 Announcement of successful appointment: early December, 2007 Contract of Employment: from early December, 2007 (There will be a possibility of delay.)

First review will be made based on the submitted application documents. Following this, shortlisted candidates will have an oral examination at Ochanomizu University, Japan. The university covers the cost of travel, if necessary. The Ochanomizu University Academic Production will correspond with successful applicants to prepare for the recruitment. There will be an initial settlement allowance paid to the appointees under our payment regulations. The university will assist, to the best of our ability, in housing, nursery, elementary education for children and other matters, if necessary.
