#### **Course details**

All courses are full-time with 12 hours tuition per week (10 live hours, 2 non-live). Students will also need to spend at least 10 further hours per week on independent guided study. Live classes will be held in the mornings, UK time. Lessons will feature lots of interaction with many opportunities for discussions. The IELTS/TOEFL scores provided here are for your guidance. We do not ask you to submit a certificate.

#### Minimum recommended entry levels:

- Pre-intermediate IELTS 4.5/TOEFL IBT 60 (or equivalent) Intermediate IELTS 5.0/TOEFL IBT 68 (or equivalent)
- Intermediate IELTS 5.5/TOEFL IBT 76 (or equivalent)
- Upper Intermediate IELTS 6.5/TOEFL IBT 95 (or equivalent)
