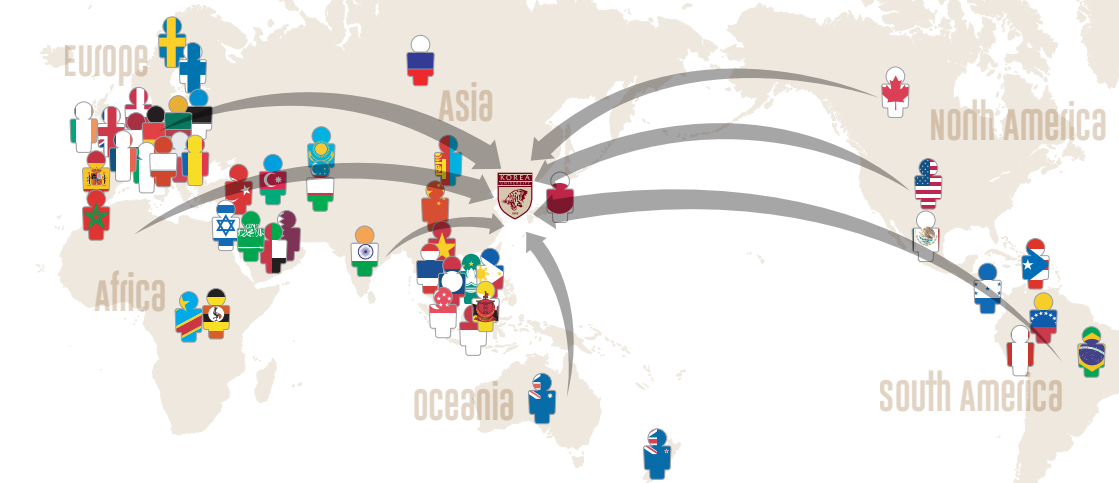

# KU ISC 2021 ADMISSIONS

**APPLICATION PERIOD** FEBRUARY 1– MAY 14, 2021

## ELIGIBILITY

### For KU ISC

- Students currently enrolled in a college/university with at least one semester of attendance & an assessment will be made to select students.

### For KU ISC Pre–College Program

- Academically motivated high school students  
- High school graduate who never attended college level institutions (under the age of 19)

## APPLICATION MATERIALS

### For Non-Korean Passport Holders

- 1 Copy of Academic Transcript
- 2 Copy of Passport(Page that shows your Photo, Name, Passport Number)
- 3 Proof of Health Insurance that is valid during the complete KU ISC period
- 4 Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian (Only for pre-college students)  
※ Document ❸ only required for students taking in-person class

### For Korean Passport Holders


- 1 Copy of Academic Transcript
- 2 Proof of Health Insurance (의료보험증)
- 3 Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian (Only for pre-college students)

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

**Application Deadline Period : February 1, 2021-May 14, 2021**

- 1 Complete all-in-one online application form at our official website  
※ Students may choose their course on the online application form  
※ Eligible students may apply for the internship on the same application form  
※ Each applicant will be given a KU ISC ID (2021XXXXXX) and asked to create a password. The ID & Password are needed for accessing application to complete payment or check payment history.
- 2 Pay the non-refundable application fee of KRW 100,000
- 3 E-mail the required application materials to isc@korea.ac.kr
- 4 Receive the Letter of Acceptance via Email
- 5 Pay the remaining tuition fee  
※ Payment deadline is May 21, 2021.  
※ Tuition fee can be paid in advance with the application fee.

## FINANCIAL BENEFITS (INTERNATIONAL FEE-PAYING STUDENTS ONLY)

 **Early Registration Benefit: KRW 200,000**  
Students who register for KU ISC 2021 by Mar. 31 are eligible for the Early Registration Benefit.

 **Re-Enrollment Benefit: KRW 100,000**  
Students who have participated in KU ISC/IWC in the past are eligible for Re-Enrollment Benefit.

## SPECIAL DISCOUNT

Students who participated in KU IWC 20-21 are eligible to receive a 50% tuition Discount.  
Students receiving this Special discount are not eligible for Early Registration Discount and Re-Enrollment Benefit.

## COURSE LOAD

**4–Week program:** 150 minutes per class X 16 classes

**6–Week program:** 100 minutes per class X 24 classes

## CREDIT

Student can take up to 3 courses. (1 course = 3 credits = 48 class hours)

## CREDIT TRANSFER

Credits earned at KU ISC are widely transferrable to most of overseas institutions at the discretion of students' home institutions. For credit transfer, students are advised to consult with appropriate academic authorities at their home institution in advance with a course description or syllabus uploaded on KU ISC website.

Please note that credit transfers are granted at the sole discretion of home institutions.

# KU ISC 2021 SCHOLARSHIP

(INTERNATIONAL FEE-PAYING STUDENTS ONLY)

## ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Students who got all A+ for the 3 courses that he/she takes in KU ISC 2021 are eligible for a scholarship of KRW 1,000,000.

## ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

Children of Korea University alumni are eligible for a scholarship of KRW 100,000 – 300,000.  
※ The amount of the scholarship varies and depends on the number of courses that students take.

## U21 / APRU SCHOLARSHIP

Students coming from U21 or APRU member institutions may receive a Fellowship Fund of either KRW 200,000 or KRW 400,000 depending on the students' home universities.

※ Those who are eligible for more than one Scholarship will automatically be awarded the one with the highest amount.
