She serves as Specially Appointed Professor, Academy for Global Leadership, Tokyo Institute of Technology since 2013, President of Japan Morocco Association since June 2014, and Outside Director at S&B Foods, Inc since 2016.

Anis Hidayah is Executive Director of Migrant CARE, a Jakarta-based and leading Indonesian organization working to protect the rights of millions of migrant workers (2004-2016), currently Director of Center for Migration Studies, Migrant CARE. She received Magister of International Law from Gadjah Mada University. She started in advocacy for migrant workers rights since 1997. She is active on research, writing articles in national newspapers and journals, resources person on migration. She is also active on international advocacy such as UN and ILO mechanism, international conferences, and so on. She serves as guest lecturer on migration and human rights in universities in Indonesia and abroad. She published books, Migration Policy in Indonesia (2013) and Irony Democracy, The Picture of Indonesian General Election Abroad (2014) and guidance books, on implementing the goal 8 of SDGs for local government in 2017 and for building villages for migrant workers' care (DESBUMI, 2016). She received international awards, such as Human Rights Watch's Alidon Des Forgers Award (2011), Yap Thian Hien Award (2014), Sarinah Award (2014), and Shine On Award (2014).

1980年代半ば以降、中国における女性の権利やジェンダー平等の活動支援者、研究者。専門は女性と暴力/性暴力、女性とメディア、女性の権利など。復旦大学(上海)、中国社会科学院研究生院(北京)を卒業・修了後、1986年から2006年まで「人民日報」、「中国婦女報」の記者を務める。中国ジェンダーと開発ネットワーク、中国反エイズ女性ネットワーク、汕頭大学女性研究センター(広東省)などの組織で共同発起人、設立コーディネータ、顧問を歴任。スウェーデン Lund 大学客員研究員(1998年)、米ハーバード大学客員研究員(2001-2002年)、英サセックス大学開発学研究機関(IDS) International Advisory Committeeメンバー。中国初の国連開発報告書(1997、国連開発、北京事務所)を含め、多数の論文(単著、共著)やジェンダー・トレーニング・マニュアルを執筆。

**Yuan FENG**

Co-founder of EQUALITY

Yuan FENG is an advocator for women's rights and gender equality in China since middle 1980s. After studied at Fudan University (Shanghai) and Graduate School of Chinese Academy of Social Sciences (Beijing), she became a journalist with the People's Daily and China Women's News during 1986-2006. Ms. Feng is co-founder, founding coordinator, or a board member of organizations such as Gender and Development Network in China, Anti Domestic Violence Network, Center for Women's Studies at Shantou University (Guangdong province). On wide topics regarding women's rights, gender and development, and gender and mass media, she is the author and co-author of many publications, including the first China Human Development Report (1997, UNDP Beijing office), and several gender training manuals. She was a visiting scholar at Harvard University (USA) during 2001-2002, Lund University (Sweden) in 1998, a member of International Advisory Committee for BRIDGE in the Institute of Development Studies (IDS) at the University of Sussex, the UK, during 2006-2015.

バングラデシュやネパールで環境保全、防災事業に女性、貧困層、被差別カーストの参加を促す事業に従事したあと、2000年より静岡大学教育学部教員、静岡大学防災総合センター兼任教員。専門は社会地理学。ジェンダー・多様性の視点に基づく防災・減災、日本・南アジア諸国を対象とした地域防災体制における女性の参加とリーダーシップに関する研究を行っている。減災と男女共同参画 研修推進センター共同代表。東日本大震災(2011年)以降、日本における災害支援や地域防災にジェンダー・多様性の視点を導入するための研修や防災体制づくりを地域住民や行政職員などと共に実施。教材作成やトレーナー養成研修にも積極的に取り組んでいる。

After working for environment conservation and disaster management projects in South Asian countries, Keiko Ikeda joined the Faculty of Education, Shizuoka University, where she concurrently serves as a faculty member for the Center for Integrated Research and Education of Natural Hazards. She is a social geographer. Her main research interests concern gender and diversity responsive disaster risk management, gendered construction of disaster vulnerability and resilience, and women's leadership in community-based disaster risk management in Japan and South Asian countries. She is a co-representative of the Training Center for Gender and Disaster Risk Reduction. After the Great East Japan Earthquake and Tsunami (2011), she has been engaged in capacity building of community disaster managers and local government officials in gender and diversity responsive disaster risk management. She is also actively involved in developing training modules and materials, and training of trainers in this field.
