

An Interview Research on Activity of the Mothers' Association for Family Planning in Oryu-ri, Korea from the 1960s to the 1970s

I received subsidy from International Research Program for the Advancement of Women in Leadership in August, 2012, and carried out research in Korea. The purpose of this research is to investigate a situation of the family planning project from the 1960s to the 1970s and to examine how it influenced the women living in villages by interviewing the former members of the Mothers' Association for Family Planning in the area called Oryu-ri, Korea.
